At the event, the Wings Credit Union Foundation announced a **\$250,000 gift to 360 Communities**, a Minnesota nonprofit providing hope and support to more than 26,000 people each year through food shelves, violence prevention and shelter services, resource centers and school success programs.

This gift is one example of how the Wings Credit Union Foundation is investing in local organizations and helping create meaningful change close to home.

Introducing Early Pay

Great news — Early Pay is now live for eligible members! If you have a qualifying account with direct deposit, you could **receive eligible** deposits **up to 2 days before your scheduled payday**.

That means quicker access to your money when it matters most—whether you are paying bills, planning ahead or simply enjoying a little more flexibility in your week.

Early Pay is only available to members with eligible accounts enrolled in direct deposit. Qualifying direct deposits include recurring payroll, government benefit payments or similar deposits via the Automated Clearing House (“ACH”) Network. At our discretion we may make funds from your direct deposit available up to two business days early. Early access to direct deposit funds depends on the timing of the payer’s payment instructions and is not guaranteed. Any funds we don’t make available early will be made available according to our Funds Availability Policy. You remain responsible if any deposit to your account is returned or otherwise uncollected. Early availability may be discontinued at any time. Transaction limits and monthly deposit limits for early processing may apply. Bank-to-bank transfers are not eligible for early payment.

Keeping you safe from scams

Fraudsters are sending text messages that appear to be from Wings and may try to pressure you into clicking a link or sharing personal information. Do not click links or respond to any suspicious text message. Wings will **never** ask for your digital banking username, password, full Social Security number or verification codes by text. If you receive a message that seems suspicious, **do not engage with it**—contact Wings directly at 800-692-2274.
